- 1. <u>Call meeting to order</u>: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Percy Thibeault at 6:30 pm.
- 2. <u>Pledge of Allegiance</u>: The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 3. <u>Minutes of December 4, 2014</u>: Clarence Roy motioned to accept the minutes of December 4, 2014, seconded by Craig Lawrence. All in favor. APPROVED.
- 4. Items to be Signed:
 - A. <u>Warrants, expenses, and payroll</u>: The Board signed and approved the warrants #101 and 102.
- 5. <u>Warrant Summary</u>: The Town Manager explained to the Selectmen that the insurance check paid in December was for the Second half of the year and will be voided and paid in January.

- 9. New Business:
 - A. <u>EMERA Maine</u>- EMERA Maine sent a letter to the Town of Frenchville asking permission to install telephone poles on the Basil Lake Road, three of which will located within Frenchville's bounders. A motion was made by Camille Bernier, seconded by Clarence Roy to approve the installation of the poles. All in favor. APPROVED.

10. Unfinished Business:

A. Sewer Report- The Board shared their concerns about the elevated flows coming from St. Agatha and added some items they thought should be part of the operation and maintenance costs shared by Frenchville and St. Agatha. Many them were maintenance, cleaning the lagoons, back flow, personnel, chemicals, outside contractors, professional development and legal fees, overtime hours, odors, cost of restrictive flow valves, charcoal filters, new traps in some houses along Route 1 by pump station #3, and equipment maintenance. The Town Manager will send correspondence to Christy Sirois explaining these concerns.

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- B. <u>Letter from Jim Laventu</u>- The Board reviewed the letter that Jim Laventu, attorney for Rob Dionne in reference to Mr. Dionne, qualifying for a junk yard permit. The Board instructed the Town Manager to send a letter to Mr. Lavertu explain their position.
- C. <u>Snow Plowing Agreement-</u>John Davis will send a letter to Dennis Roy along with a copy of the snow plowing agreement that will allow the Public Works Department to push snow on Mr. Roy's land.
- D. Tax Acquired Properties- The Town Manager informed the Board that the taxes and sewer fees have been paid on the two properties that the Town had foreclosed on.
- E. <u>Three to Five-year Plan</u>-The Board discussed some of the items on the plan and decided to take the rest up as they appeared during the review of the draft budget.

11. Other Business:

- A. <u>Abatement-The Board reviewed a tax abatement request and instructed the Town Manager to put this on his list of requests for the tax assessor to examined when he come to Frenchville next spring.</u>
- B. <u>Montfort Heights</u>-For Selectmen information, the Town Manager shared a letter he received informing people that Montfort Heights has vacancies at its facility for people who qualify.
- C. <u>Cleaning Oven at the Community Center</u>-There appears to be a problem with cleaning the oven at the Community Center after an event is held. The Board decided to make it clear on the application that any party that plans to use the oven make a down payment to offset any charges that the Town will have to pay to have the oven cleaned. If the oven is cleaned by the group that rents the center, the down payment will be returned.
- D. <u>General Assistance</u>-The Town has exceeded its budget amount for General Assistance. John Davis talked to the legal Department of Maine Municipal Association and was told that no motion was necessary to exceed the budget, and the excess could be paid from another account and then has this notified by the people at the Town Meeting in March 2015.
