9. New Business: There were no new business to report.

10. Unfinished Business:

- **A.** <u>Snowplowing Agreements</u>- the Board signed some snowplowing agreements that will legally allow Public Works to plow snow and/or turnaround on private property. The Town is waiting for a couple more agreements to arrive in the mail.
- **B.** Petition for an Ambulance Service in Frenchville- the Board agreed to move forward with the certified petition that Linda Picard has worked so diligently on. Percy Thibeault explained to Linda that the petition would be sent to the Maine Municipal Association to confirm that the wording is correct. If such confirmation is made, the Board will hold a public hearing to discuss this matter.
- C. <u>Christmas Party for Town Employees</u>- A motion was made by Andrew McQuarrie, seconded by Clarence Roy, to have a Christmas Party for the Town Employees. All in favor. APPROVED. The Town manager will make the arrangements.
- D. Letter from Bob Dionne's Attorney- John Davis discussed a letter he has received from Mr. Dionne's attorney explaining that the \$100 advertisement fee that Bob owes the Town will be paid in exchange for a permit for Mr. Dionne to operate his junk yard. The Board is not in agreement with this. A motion was made by Andrew McQuarrie, seconded by Clarence Roy, that in order for Mr. Dionne to get his permit, he will have to pay the \$100 advertisement fee plus \$50 permit fee and the advertisement fee for the 2014-2015 public hearing. - E. <u>Loan for Truck</u>- A motion was made by Clarence Roy, seconded by Andrew McQuarrie, to get the loan for \$39,000 through Acadia Federal Credit Union. All in favor. APPROVED.
